December 4, WednesdayDepart Los Angeles on an overnight to New York JFK Airport.

December 05, ThursdayArrive New York, JFK airport early morning and connect to South Africa Airways flight to Johannesburg.

December 06, Friday....Arrive Johannesburg in the morning, after immigration and customs board your flight to Cape Town. Arrive Cape Town International Airport, collect your luggage and meet the



guide at the arrivals lounge and transfer to the hotel situated in the vibrant <u>V&A</u> <u>Waterfront</u>. The rest of the day is at your leisure. Accommodation: <u>Southern Sun</u> <u>Cullinan Hotel</u>
