Our safari hits all of the incredible spots, from the unique eco-system of Ngorongoro Crater, the vast savannahs of the Serengeti plains and the flamingo-lined shores of Lake Manyara. This safari is typical of classic Tanzania safari. Short and sweet!

Day 1: Sunday, Depart USA

Your journey begins as you board your flight from USA to Arusha via Amsterdam.

Day 2: Monday: Amsterdam / Arrive Arusha,

Connect your flight to Arusha International Airport in Amsterdam. Upon arrival in Arusha; after customs and immigration formalities we drive to our accommodation for the night, [Lake Duluti Hotel](#) located on a coffee plantation on the shores of Lake Duluti. The hotel, designed as an authentic African village, guests are housed in cottages thatched with banana fronds, surrounded by tropical shade trees and bougainvillea. All guest rooms have en suite bathrooms and all amenities. The hotel boasts magnificent views of the mighty snow-capped Mount Kilimanjaro on one side and Lake Duluti and the rugged peaks of Mount Meru on the other.

Day 3: Tuesday: Lake Manyara National Park

Drive to Lake Manyara National Park, an ornithological paradise inhabited by over 350 bird species. Elusive tree-climbing lions lay in wait on branches while eagles, vultures, storks, swifts and swallows glide along the spectacular cliffs overlooking the pink shimmering lake with thousands of flamingos. Stretch your legs near the hippo pool. Examine the amazing 'upside-down' baobab tree, and the magnificent giant fig and mahogany trees that give shelter to blue vervet monkey, baboon, bushbuck and elephant. On the edge of the Rift Valley escarpment overlooking Lake Manyara is your accommodation for the night, [Lake Manyara Serena Safari Lodge](#) located on the edge of the Mto Wa Mbu escarpment, overlooking the Great Rift Valley and the stunning Manyara soda lake. The circular shape of the buildings is a tribute to indigenous architectural traditions. All rooms have en suite facilities and private balconies overlooking the escarpment and the lake beyond. There is a curio shop, swimming pool with pool bar. Arrive on time for lunch and late afternoon game drive. **Meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner**

Day 4: Wednesday: Serengeti National Park

After breakfast you drive the world's best-known park, the Serengeti. Named after the Masai word, 'Siringet' for endless plains of short and long grass. The Serengeti is well known for its large prides of lion, cheetah, packs of wild dog and for nearly a million or so wildebeest. Overnight at [Serengeti Serena Lodge](#)

Day 5: Thursday: Serengeti National Park

Spend another day in the Serengeti with morning and early evening scheduled game drives. Optional activities are available and booked locally - balloon safari and visit to Masai village.

Day 6 & 7: Friday/ Saturday: Ngorongoro

Conservation Area — After breakfast drive to Ngorongoro Crater – an extinct volcano and World Heritage site. En route stop at Olduvai Gorge for a short visit to the site of the remains of prehistoric man discovered by Dr. Leakey. Ngorongoro is a **caldera**, a depression on the land surface caused by the collapse of Volcanic mountain thought to have been formed about 3 million years ago. The crater measures approximately 10-12 miles across and has an area of 117 square miles. Its heavily forested rim rises 2000 feet above the crater's floor to an elevation of 7,500 feet. This natural amphitheater measures approximately 12 mile in diameter and 117 square miles area. It is home to up to 30,000 animals, however the numbers change by seasons. Almost half being wildebeest and Zebra. Here you will see large pride of lions, elephants with large tusks as well as black rhinos, buffalos, birds and all manner of antelopes, hyenas, hippos ostrich and may others. Leopards are very elusive so they may occasionally be seen in the trees of the forest surrounding the rate, while cheetahs are also present. Large herds of giraffe live on the rim of the crater and will also be seen on the drive to Olduvai Gorge and the Serengeti. Countless flamingo form a pink blanket over the soda ash lakes after the rain season. Ngorongoro is one of the few places you are quite sure of seeing a rhino. In the forest s and the swamped areas one can find hippos, rhinos, elephants and waterbucks.

Ngorongoro conservation area is also home to Olduvai Gorge or Oldupai Gorge, one of the most important anthropological sites in the world and has been instrumental in furthering the understanding of early human evolution.

This site is significant in showing increased developmental and social complexities in early humans. Evidence of this is shown in the production and use of stone tools, which indicates the increase in cognitive capacities. Evidence also indicates the practices of both scavenging and hunting, which are highlighted by the evidence of gnaw marks predating cut marks, and comparisons on percentages of meat versus plant in the early hominid diet. Furthermore, the collection of tools and animal remains in a central area is evidence of increases in social interaction and communal activity.

Spend 2 nights at [Ngorongoro Serena Lodge](#), with a game drive at the floor of the crater and the rest of the time participate in optional activities such as: a guided nature walk around the lodge or hikes from the hotel away from the crater.

Meals: breakfast, lunch dinner

Day 08: Sunday: Arusha /Amsterdam

After breakfast drive to Arusha. Later transfer to the airport for your flight departure. Meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner.

Day 9: Monday: Amsterdam/ USA

Arrive Amsterdam in the morning and connect your flight home.

- Although safaris in Tanzania are not Safaris physically demanding but they are in remote locations over rough terrain. This trip is perfect for active people in good health and with the spirit of adventure. Participants must be able to tolerate riding on uncomfortably uneven, bumpy roads (some with many potholes) for long periods of time (6-9 hours maximum), as well as some off-road experiences when opportunities allow.
- Participants must be able to climb in and out of, as well as move around in confined quarters within safari 4 x 4 vehicles, minibuses, and small aircrafts unassisted. Participants must be able to stand and/or walk moderate distances when visiting villages, towns, or other sites.

AIR SCHEDULES

- Please check with us before purchasing your airline tickets to ensure your trip has the necessary minimum number of participants required to operate. Please note we can book flights for this trip, however please note, choosing the best possible air arrangements for our travelers is always a challenge. TRIP CANCELTION, INTERRUPTION AND MEDICAL INSURANCE

TRIP CANCELTION AND REFUNDS

All cancellation must be advised in writing, signed by the safari participant (s). Cancellation are effective on the day they are received by To Africa Tour and Safaris. The following cancellation charges will be payable to land only depending upon the number of days prior to departure date when To Africa Tours and Safaris receives your notice of cancellation.

- More than 90 days a cancellation fee of \$200 per person applies.
- 89 and 60 days a cancellation fee of 30% of the total cost of the safari applies
- 59 and 30 days 50% of the total cost of the safari applies
- Less than 29 days a cancellation of 100% of the total cost of the safari applies
- Cancellation penalties on airfare are additional to the land package and will depend on the type/class of airfare and individual airlines terms and conditions applicable.
- No refund for any unused portions of the tour program once tour has commenced.

USEFUL INFORMATION FOR TRAVEL TO TANZANIA

PASSPORT AND VISAS

USA citizens must possess a valid U.S. passport for travel to Tanzania. It must be valid 6 months beyond your intended stay in Kenya and must have 2-4 completely blank pages facing each other. All USA citizens an entry visa to Tanzania.

MONEY MATTERS:

The official Tanzania currency is Tanzania Shilling. The Tanzanian shilling (Tsh.) is divided into 100cents. Notes are in denomination of 200, 500, 1000, and 10,000 shillings. Coins are in order of 10, 20, 50, 100 and 200 shillings. Money can be changed in banks, bureaux de change and other accredited points such as hotels. Credit cards (Access, Master Card, Visa, American Express, Euro Card and Diners) are accepted by large hotels around the country. Travelers' cheques in US dollars and Pound Sterling are recommended, although Euros are also accepted. Banking hours in major towns are from Monday to Friday (08.30 - 16.00 hrs), Saturday from 08.30 hrs - 13.30 hrs. These may vary in smaller towns. ATM and 24 hour cash machines are available in branches of major banks and accept international VISA cards. Please note that banks are closed on Sundays.

The recommended amount of money to bring in cash is between \$500—\$800.00 minimum in U.S dollars. This money should include your tips and gratuities. In hotels/Lodges/ Camps you can leave U.S. dollars or Kenya Shilling.

ELECTRICITY

The electricity supply in Kenya is 220/240 v 50hz. Plugs are 3 point square. You will need to bring your own converter and adapter (universal adapter with square three prongs) for recharging camera batteries, hairdryers, and electric shavers. Or instead you can bring devises that use batteries to operate and a supply of batteries.

HEALTH RECOMMENDATION

The following vaccinations are recommended: Tetanus, typhoid, polio, Hepatitis A&B. Consult your doctor or local health department, travel clinic or immunizations center. Also recommended is anti-Malaria medication. For more information on health in Tanzania please visit [CDC](#) website

WHAT TO PACK FOR THIS TRIP

When packing keep in mind on international flights you are allowed one check-in luggage weighing 50 pounds. Your carry-on luggage only maximum of 13 pounds. (Please verify with individual airline for luggage requirements) On inter-park flights on safari you are allowed 33 pounds. Also while on safari the space in the vehicles is limited. It is recommended you use soft sided luggage /duffel bag with wheels which is easier to transport in safari vehicles and on inter-park flights. It is also advisable, in addition to your check-in luggage to bring a small carry-on bag with everything that is essential and valuable, such as camera equipment, you medications, important travel documents, passports, money etc. for more information and regulations regarding contents of carry-on luggage please visit this website <http://www.tsa.gov/travelers>.

Safaris are extremely informal vacations, so pack lightly. All the lodges allow casual clothing and traditional safari wear while dining. It is recommended you bring light weight comfortable washable clothes. Most lodges and camps will launder your clothes for free or a small fee (\$2 - \$3 per item) within 24-hours. Loose fitting, casual and comfortable clothing is recommended. Bright colors are not suitable for game viewing, and game drives are conducted in the early morning and late afternoon, which can be cold, especially in winter. Light cotton trousers or shorts and shirts (both long and short sleeved), comfortable walking shoes, windbreaker, sunhat.
